2-1-1

2-1-1 is a free accessible telephone number that enables everyone to access the vital community services they need. 2-1-1 provides a “one-stop” service for vital information by providing the “right” phone number for the “right” resource needed. It is the equivalent of 9-1-1 but for non-emergency health and human services. Every call is confidential.

Every hour of every day, someone requires essential services such as:
